## Summary of Programme

25% of the course will be devoted to theoretical aspects of bronchoscopy in children

- Equipment needed to set up a bronchoscopy in children (flexible & rigid bronchoscopy)
- Indications, contraindications
- Anaesthesia, sedation, tolerance, side effects
- Anatomical findings: upper and lower airways (normal/abnormal)
- Bronchoalveolar lavage (techniques, indications, results)
- Bronchial brushing, endobronchial biopsy, transbronchial biopsy
- Tracheobronchial foreign bodies: Presentation and management in children
- FB in NICU/PICU

25% of the course will be devoted to discussions of cases during video sessions

50% of the course will be devoted to hands-on sessions. Participants will work on anesthetised piglets in an operating room under supervision of international recognised tutors. Six sessions lasting 90 minutes will focus on:

- Practical handling (flexible and rigid bronchoscopy)
- Bronchoalveolar lavage
- Bronchial biopsy
- Transbronchial biopsy
- Intubation with the flexible bronchoscope
- Foreign body removal
